Energy report has been done , quotes are required for cost of roof and insulation. Cllr Still will attend Storengy meeting in September when grants for improving insulation etc. may be decided.

A Fire and Rescue inspection was carried out and there are several requirements to be addressed by Social Committee.

Capital Place has planning permission for alterations but nothing happening yet.

Brookview House (listed building) still has a Planning application pending.

Hulme Hall is for sale.

Lower Peover PC are doing a Neighbourhood Plan.

Planning Enforcement Officer has sorted out sign at Harrison Drive.

9. Correspondence.

Cllr Wilson had received an anonymous letter complaining about extra traffic on Wash Lane. Councillors who live close by had not noticed anything out of the ordinary .The person who has concerns should sign the letter.

Highways have been informed about the problem of potholes and sunken culvert on New Platt Lane. Fay Jones would like to be involved in Best Kept Village Competition-Clerk to try and get details for her.

10. Comments/inquiries/reports.

There is a plan to cancel Bus Route 319. Without there is no Public transport in the Village, no transport to Doctors or shops or to meet with bus to Leighton Hopital. Consultation at present, questionnaire online and paper copy at Library.

Cllr Mrs Wilson went to Inovyn meeting, they are drilling 4 new wells at Hulme Hall and they have plans for 11 in total.

Storengy are using 20 of their 28 wells ,the remaining 8 to return to Inovyn.

Keuper Gas Storage scheme still in negotiation with land owners.

HS2 scheme still in discussion with Inovyn

Crematorium in Lostock Green will be operational in 2018 , some concerns re landscaping.

Cheshire Show, Cllr Mrs Owens went at the invitation of Manchester Airport for afternoon tea. She saw a 3D presentation on Airport Development.

Cllr Mrs Gibbison-Cheshire Neighbourhood Watch is operational.

Cllr. Mrs Owens had concerns Re Oak Tree on Harrison Drive which has paint marks on it. She also asks who maintains ' Tree of Imagination.'

The Sandstone Bridge on A50 opposite Mount Pleasant Nursing Home is damaged, Highways have been informed.

Cllr Roberts has had his attention drawn to problem of vey large vehicles using bridge on Hulme Hall Lane over the motorway. This bridge was originally for agricultural vehicles. Clerk to ask Highways about weight restriction signage.
